The renovation of an existing Aged Care Facility or an existing building which has been converted to an aged care facility that meets current certification requirements and shows some of the following features:

- Creative layout and space utilisation
- Innovative use of building finishes
- Innovative building fabric
- Innovative design

- Design brief - half a page
- Operational brief - half a page
- Mission statement for facility - 4 lines
- Company philosophy - 4 lines
- How do you see the future of Aged Care - 4 lines
- How does the building relate to the future - 4 lines
- List of equipment used in laundry and kitchen and why
- What are you trying to achieve with this facility - 4 lines

SUBMISSIONS TO CONSIST OF:

- 4 large colour photos of residents accommodation, preferably A4 (can be computer printed)
- 4 color photos of resident's bathrooms
- 6 colour photos of external elevations
- 4 of outlook in each direction
- 4 colour photos of entry and reception area
- 2 colour photos of courtyards or gardens
